## *Superintendent's Message*

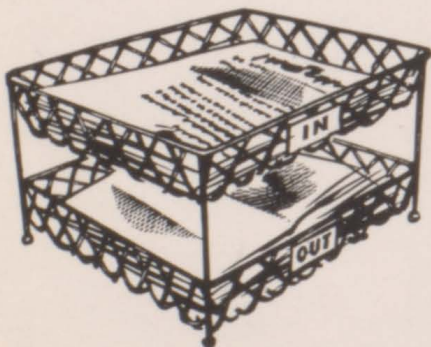

## Library Club

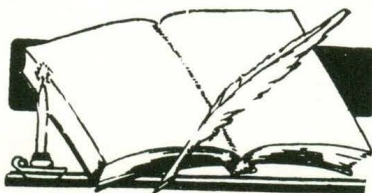
