We are looking forward to making our club a permanent organization in this high school as a necessary and entertaining facet of our learning of the language of another country.

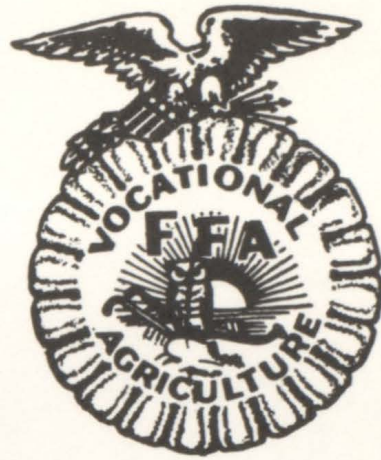
