5. **INDIANAPOLIS 500** — Mario Andretti receives congratulations from car owner Granatelli for his record speed of 160.218 MPH in the 500 mile race. Andretti's face still bears the marks of burns received in a crash and fire during time trials. (May, '69)
6. **TIPTOEING THROUGH THE TULIPS** — Tiny Tim Khaury and his 17-year-old bride, the former Victoria Budinger, pose on the stage of the Johnny Carson show in New York City. The couple was married on the program.

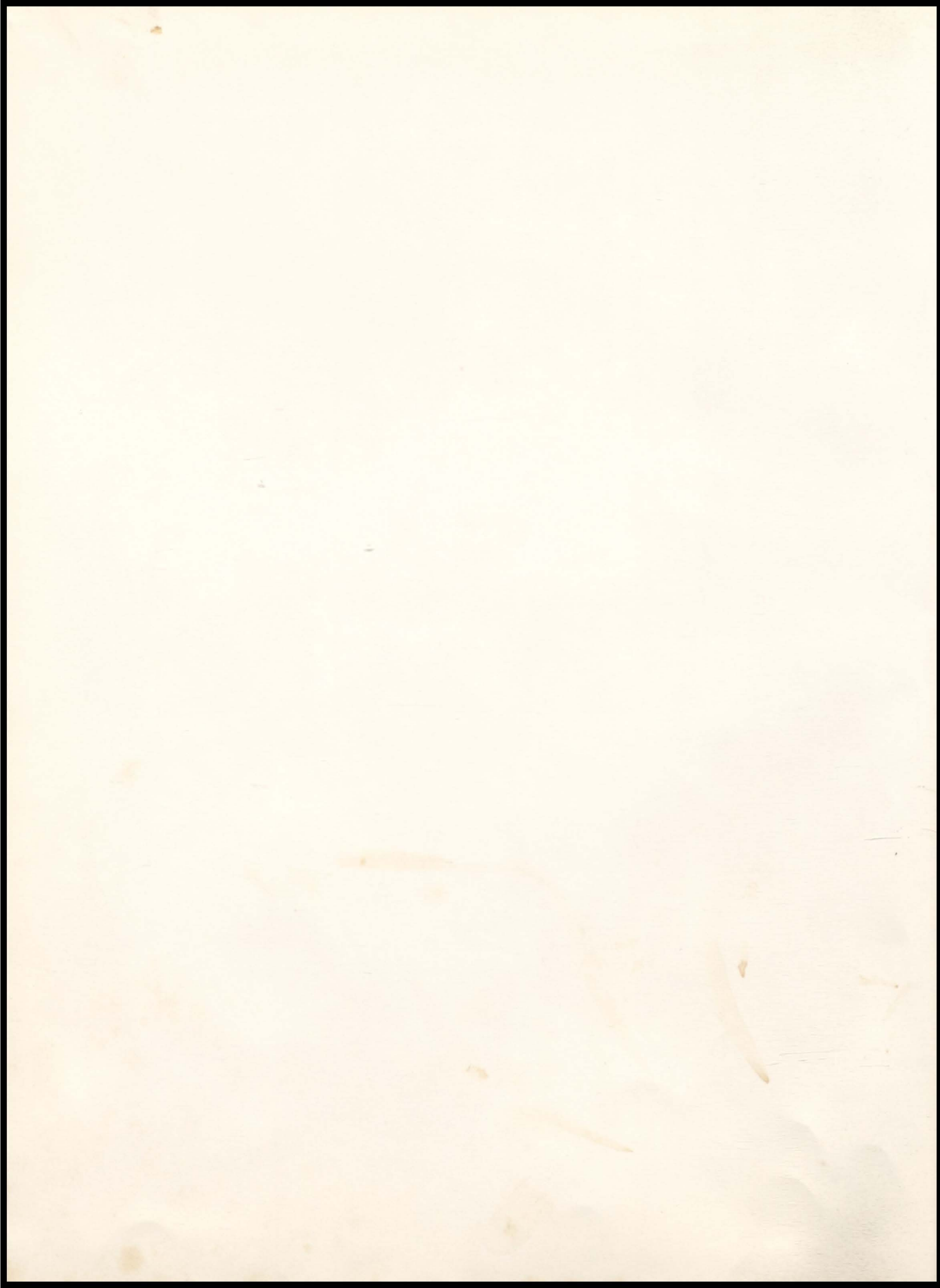
- 7. **HURRICANE CAMILLE** — Five persons await rescue on rail tracks between Gulfport and New Orleans after winds had lifted their house.

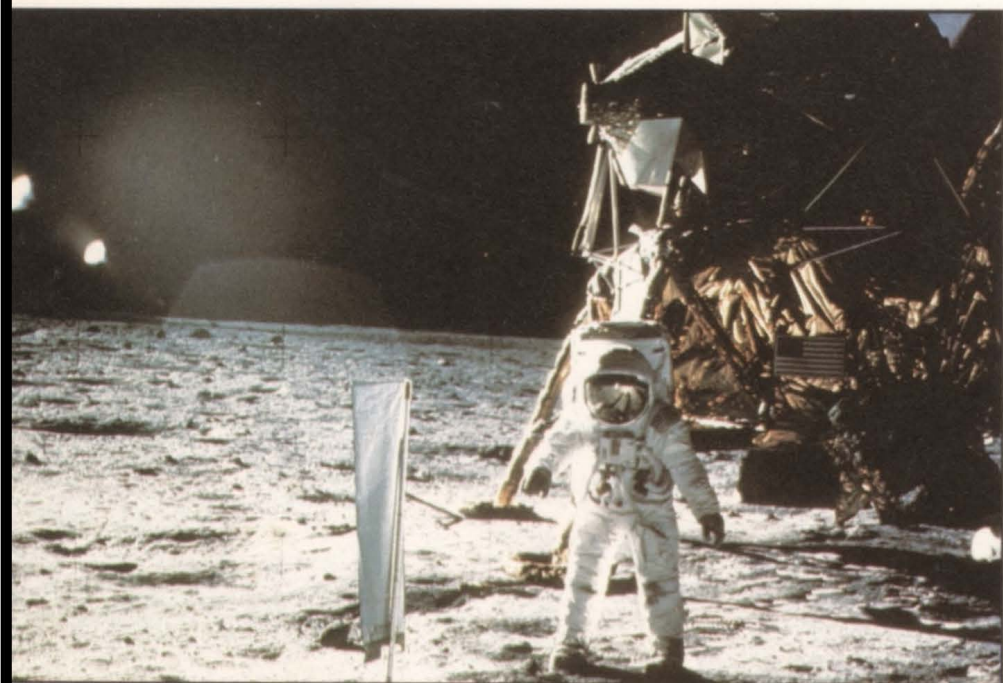

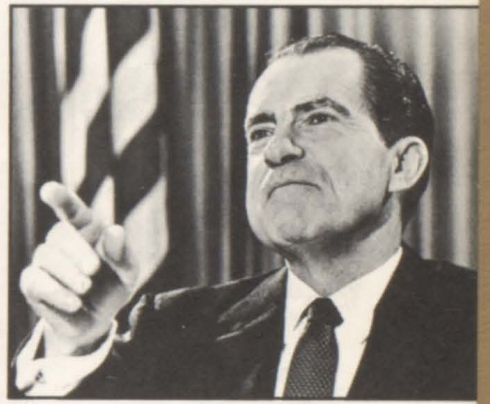
