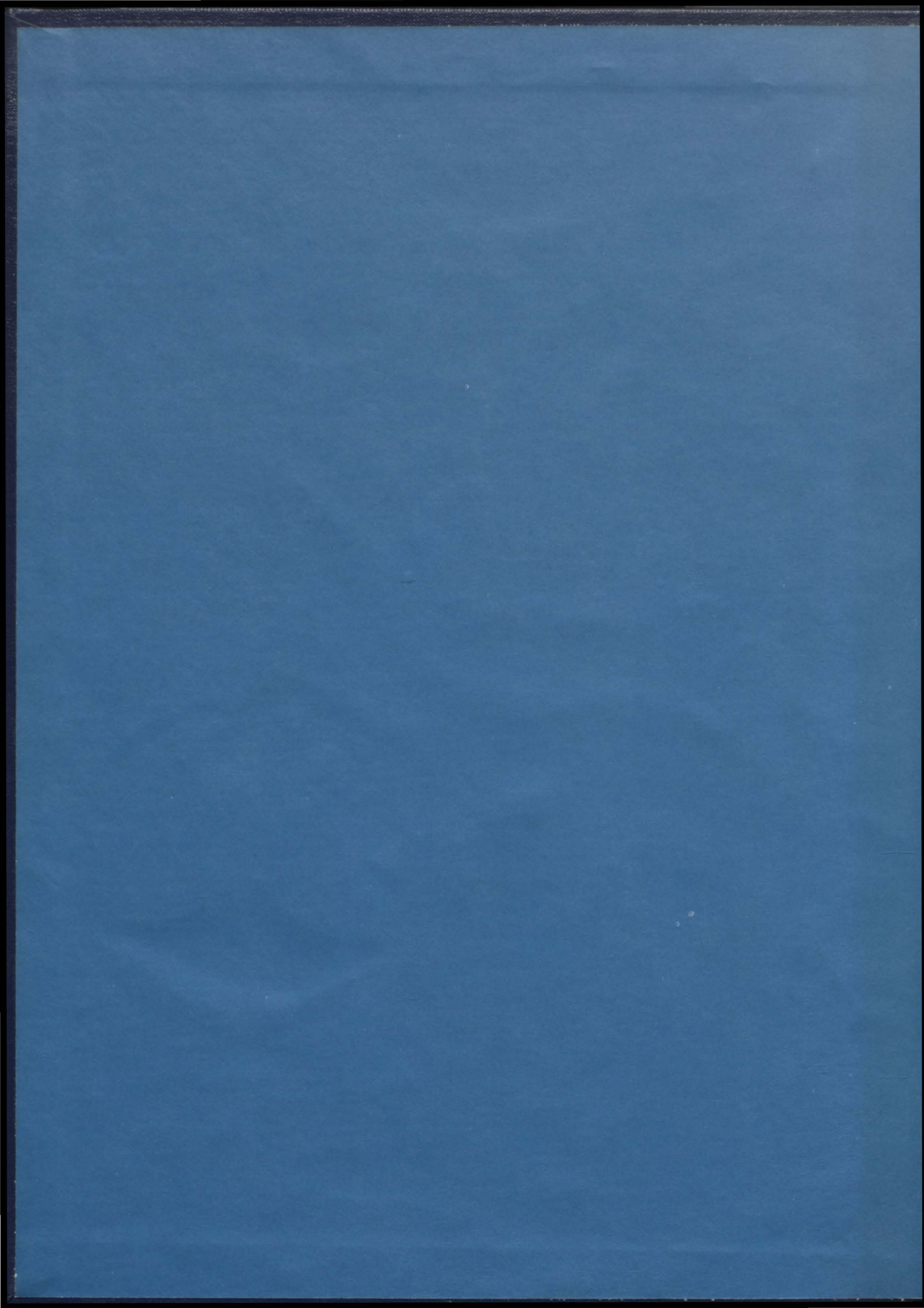

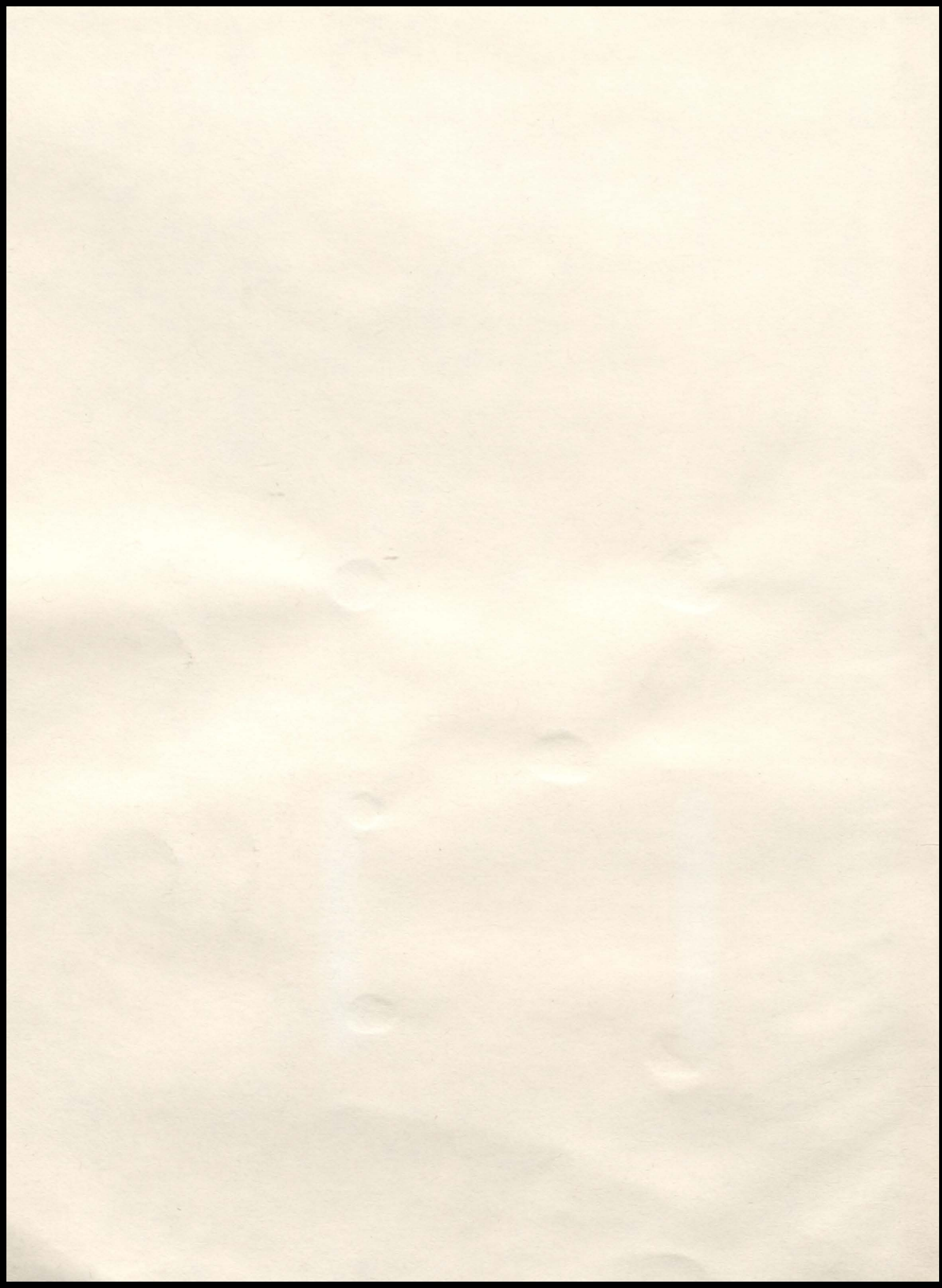














AS THERE IS HOPE

Should keep our hope alive.

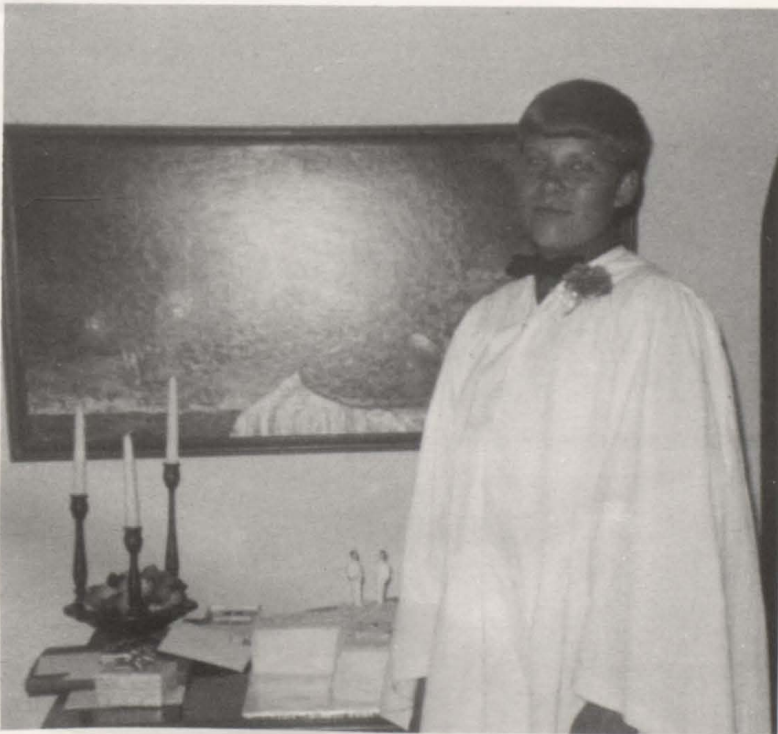
