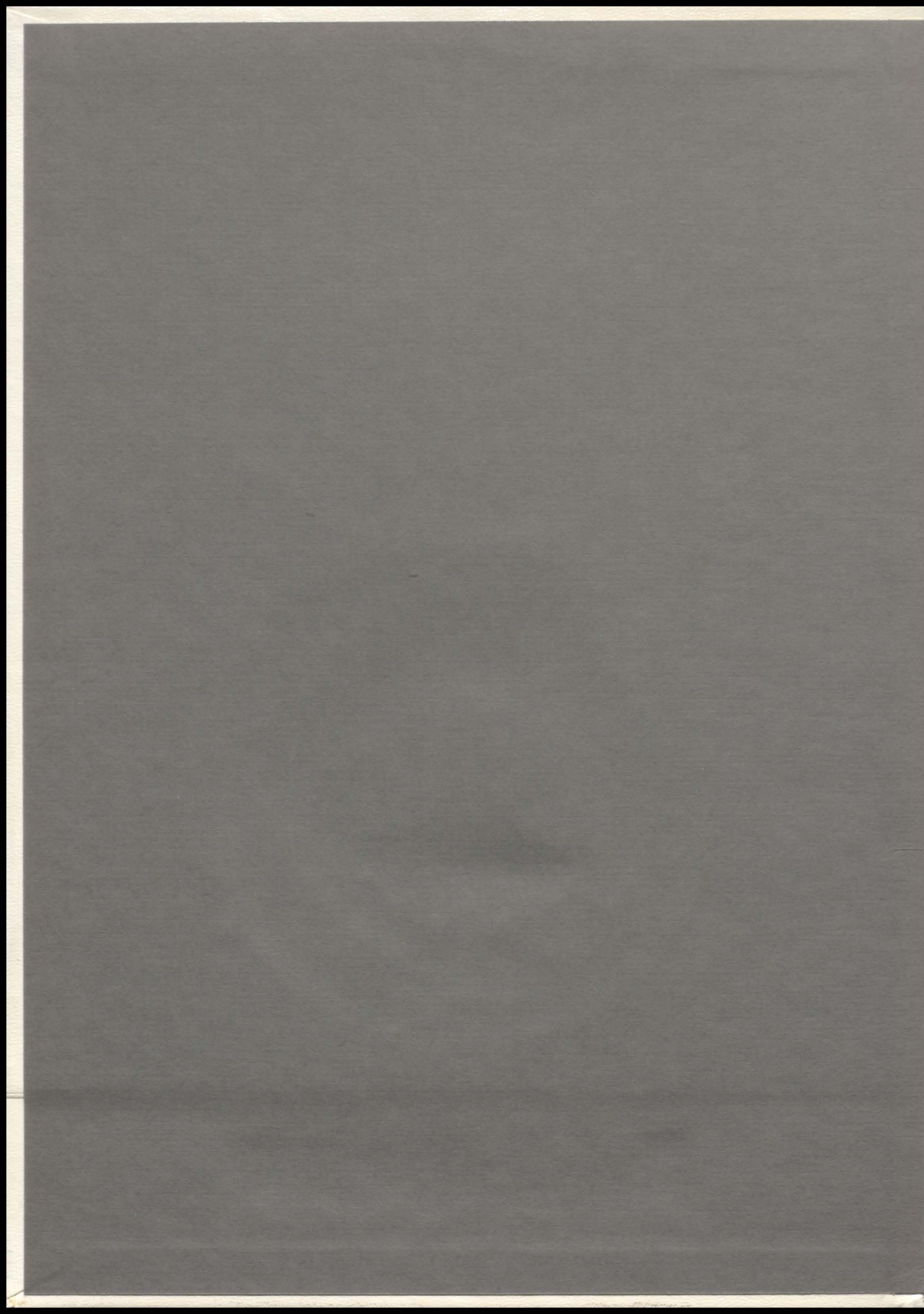
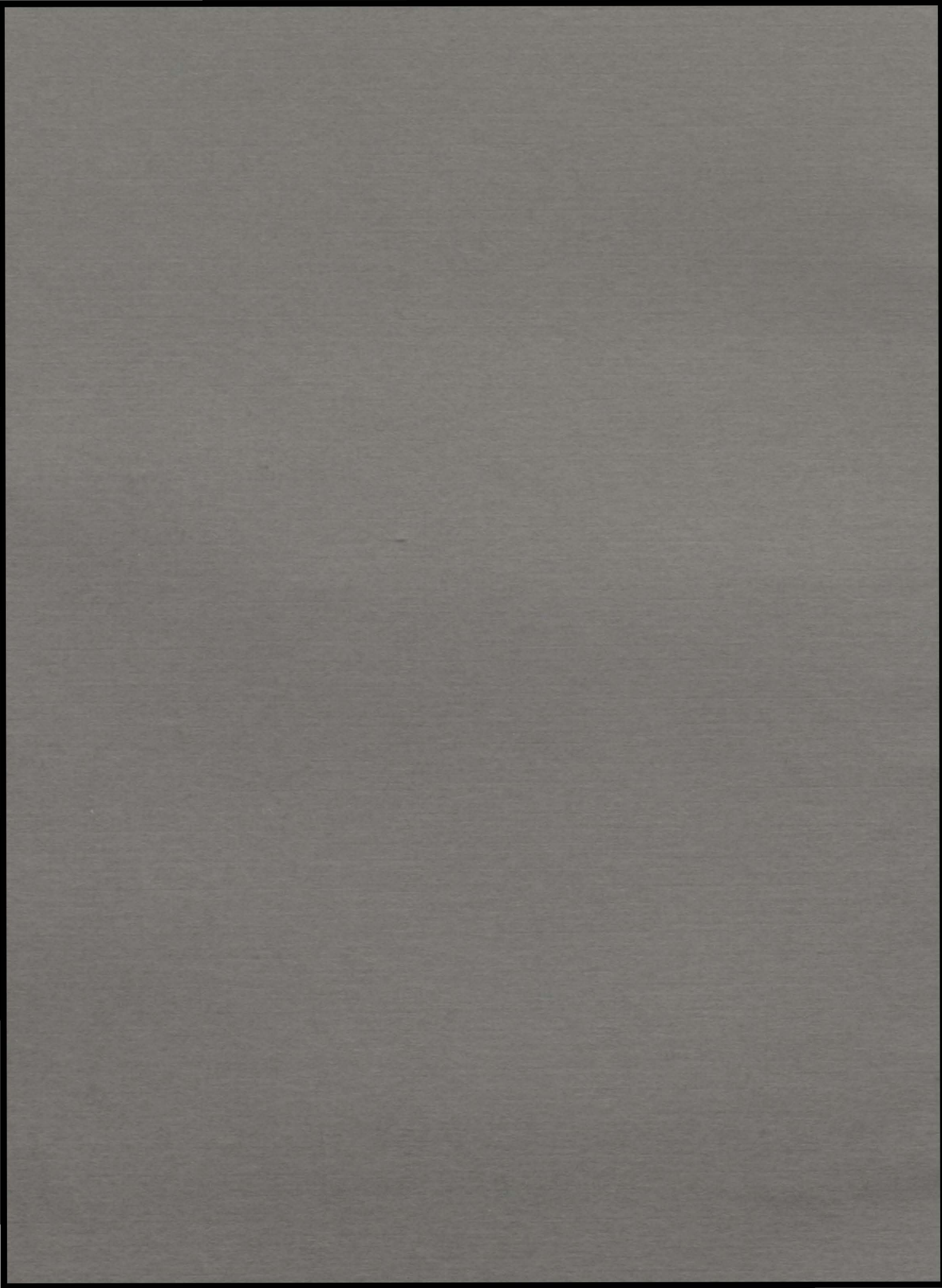
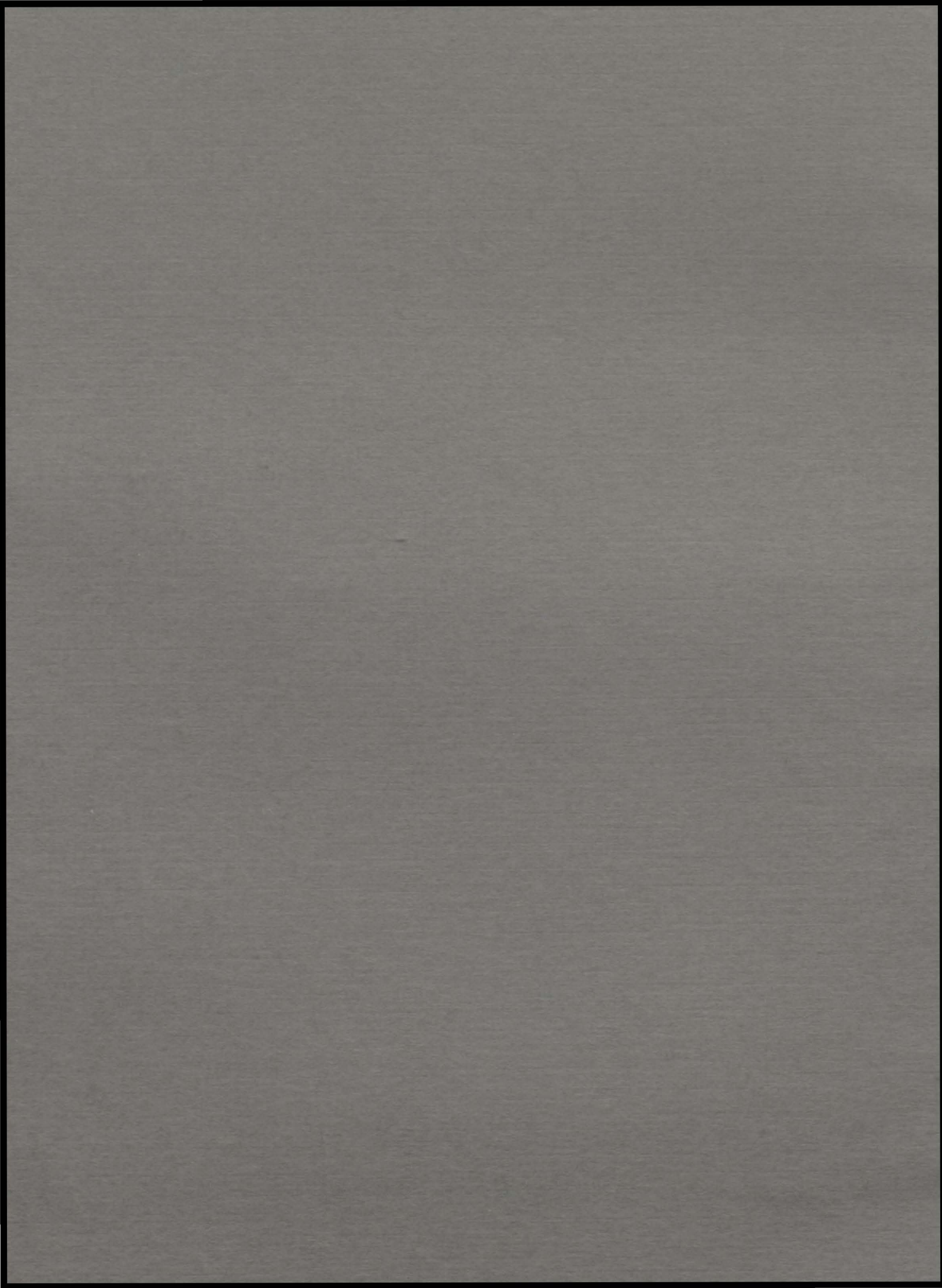

So we dug deeper into our soil.

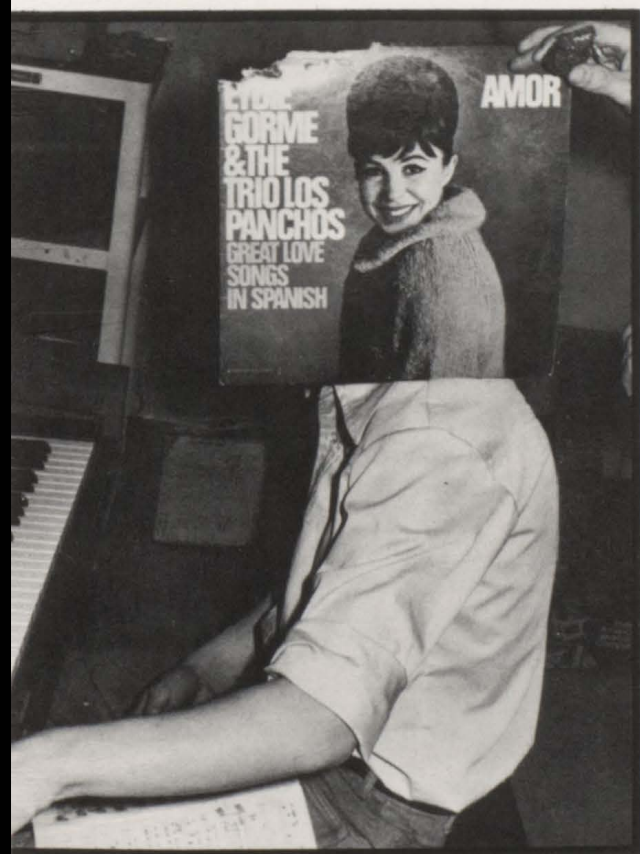
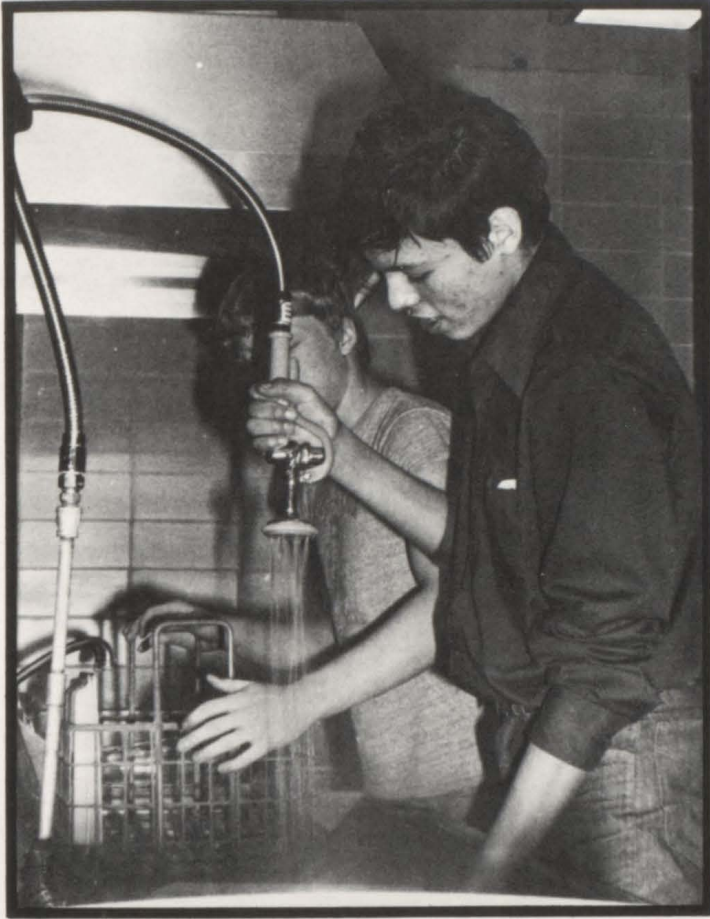

Freshmen Science is a required course for Freshmen taught by Mr. Fox. It includes the many aspects of Physical Science.

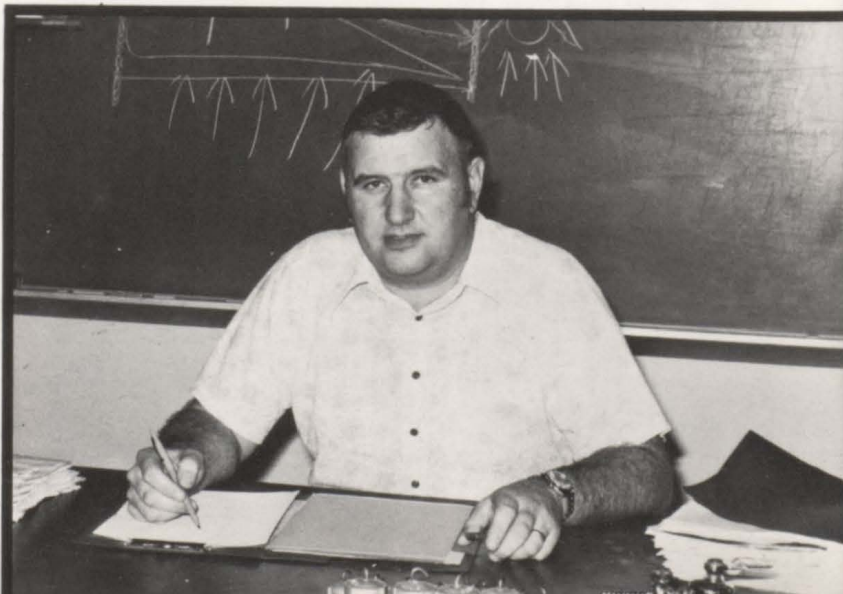
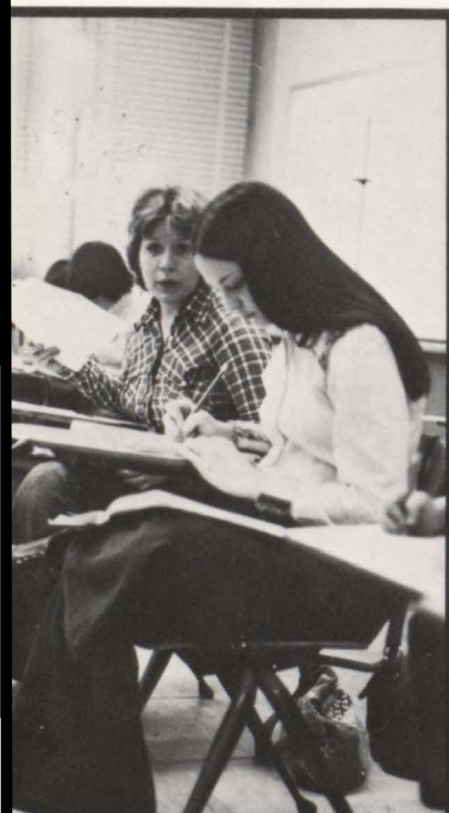
