Is a job in itself.

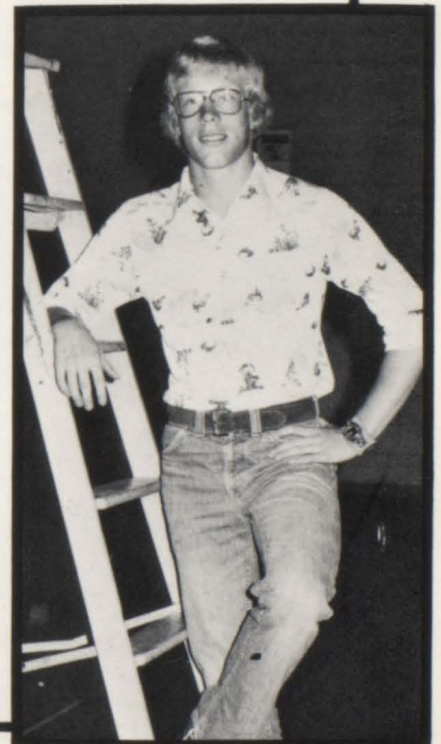
The Art Club is a unique one

This I know.

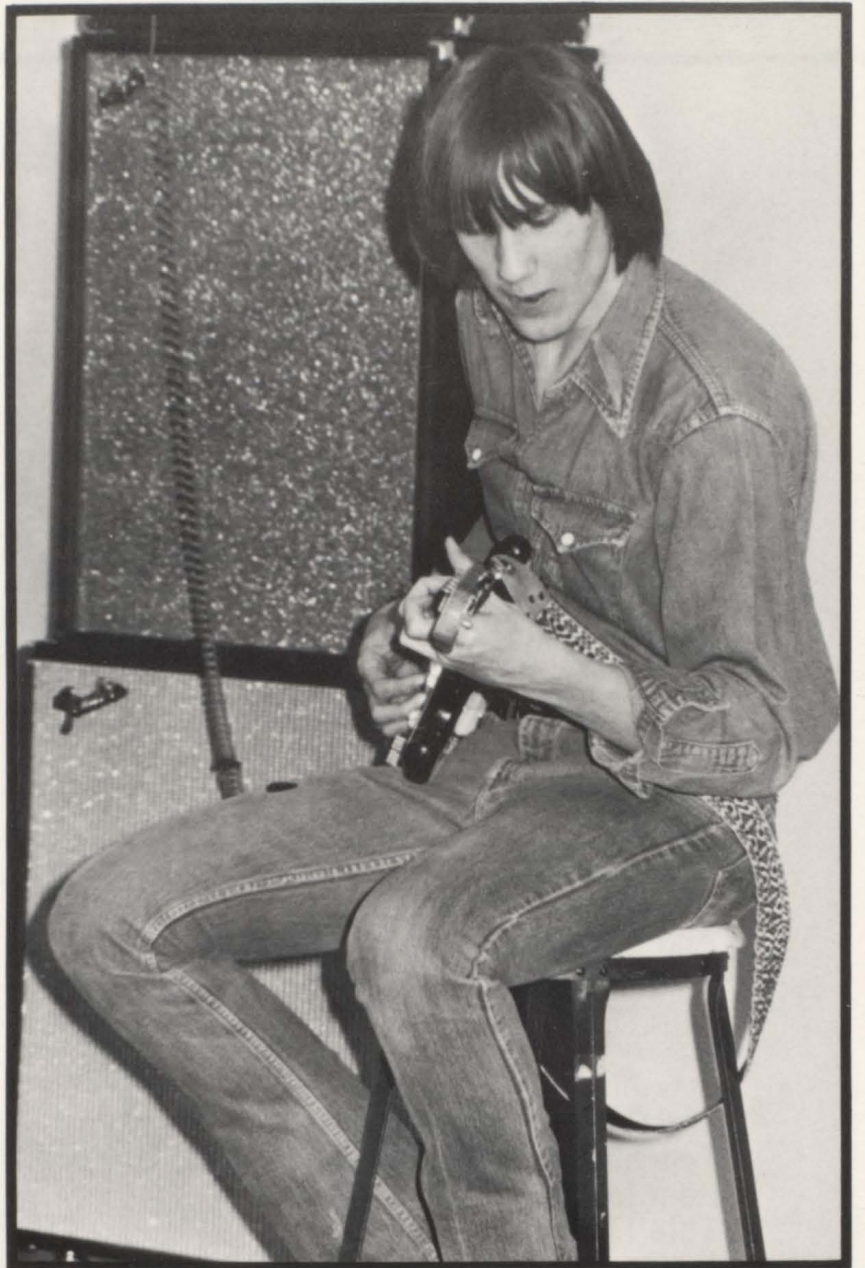
