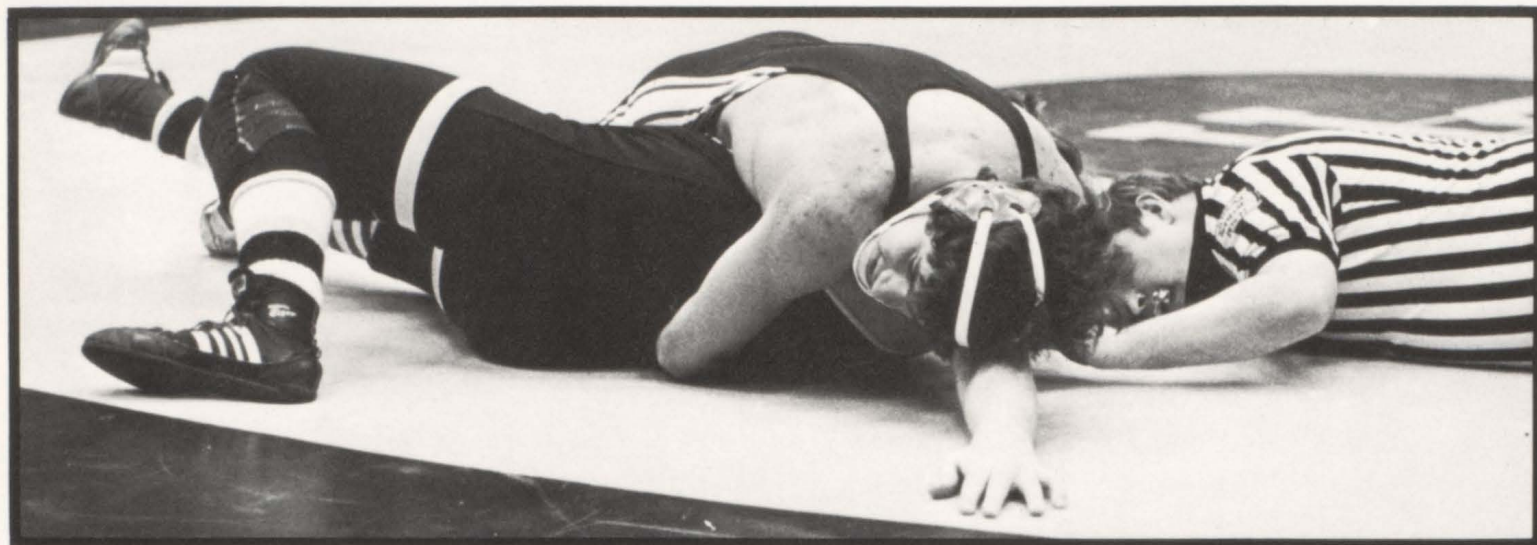
National Merit Scholarship Finalists
